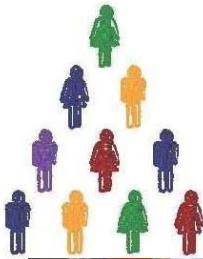

New Flexible Booking and 15% Sibling Discount

Quality Child Care When YOU Need It

From September, parents using the Triangle After School Club have been able to book by the hour following the introduction of a new flexible booking option. In addition to the full session which runs from 3.15pm – 6pm, you can now book your children into the Club for just an hour after school, if that's all you need. The charge will be £4.00 / hour and you can book as often or as little as you like.

We hope this will offer a greater level of support to parents in the village, and it's not just working parents who can benefit, it is available to anyone who needs that extra hour or two in their day. So whether you are treating yourself to a long lunch with

a friend, or just trying to catch up with the endless jobs at home - we can help!

We have also introduced a 15% discount for siblings. This is to try to help keep the costs down for parents who have two or more children that need after school care.

In June of this year our team of six riders set off on the 25 mile sponsored bike ride to raise funds for the Triangle. First home from the team was Elite Start rider, Dave Trevena, who completed the course in just 1 hour 6 minutes. The remaining team members (Adam Piggott, Jan Angell, Vanessa Beech, Anthony Beech and Katrina Meggitt) managed to stay together for most of the course and the team came home in a very respectable time of 2 hours 4 minutes and has so far raised a very impressive £845. 75.
