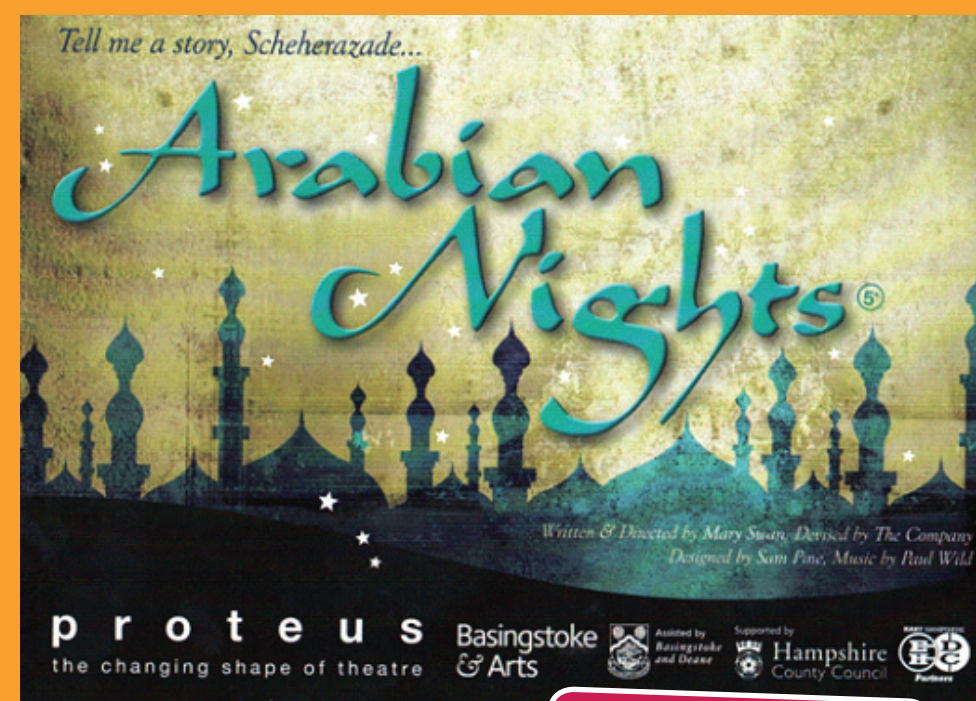


**The Christmas Raffle**
