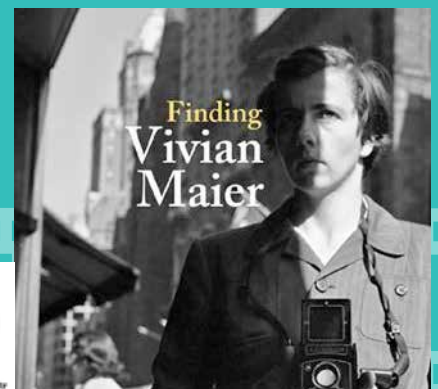

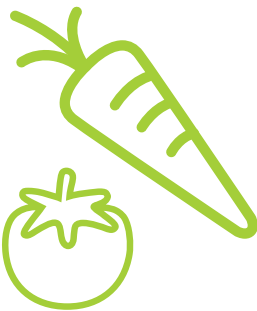
### THE COFFEE BAR CHARITY MORNING
